EVERGREEN ARTIFICIAL GRASS





To ensure a smooth and even surface for your artificial grass, proper base preparation is essential. Follow these steps:

- Clear the Area: Remove existing soil, weeds, and roots as needed. The final surface quality will depend on how well the base is prepared.
- Install Landscape Fabric: Lay down landscape fabric to prevent weed growth, ensuring each section overlaps by at least 12/18 inches.
- Create a Solid base: Add a 4-6 inch layer of compacted crushed stone, followed by a ¾-inch layer of quarry screenings or stone dust.
- Pre-Installation Tip: Before laying the artificial grass, expose it to sunlight for a few hours to allow for natural expansion.





Before installing: It is advisable to leave the StonehengeUS
Evergreen Artificial Grass in sunlight and heat for a few hours to allow for expansion.



Step 2 | Installing Evergreen Artificial Grass

- Roll Out the Turf: Roll out and position the artificial grass Keeping the material taut.
- Align Additional Rolls: Unroll the next piece in the same direction, ensuring the blade pattern aligns.
 Lightly brush the edges to blend the fibers.
- **Seam Positioning:** Maintain a gap of approximately 1/8" to 1/4" between connecting sections of turf.
- **Seam Tape Application:** Lay seam tape along the seam's center, making sure it remains flat. A Knee Kicker tool can help.
- Adhesive Application: Apply a high-strength
 hardscape adhesive keeping the adhesive 1" from
 the center using an adhesive gun, apply adhesive in
 a serpentine pattern about 1 inch away from the
 center of the seam tape (see example image right).
 Avoid adding excess adhesive.
- Closing the Seam: Draw the edges together little by little, ensuring they stay aligned as you bring them together.
- **Securing the Seam:** Apply firm pressure along the seam to ensure strong adhesion.
- **Allow for Curing:** Let the adhesive set for hours before proceeding with additional steps.

Step 3 | Final Securing & Trimming

- **Nailing the Edges:** Secure the perimeter by nailing every 6 inches using 10-inch spiral spikes, ensuring they sit flush without bending the fibers.
- **Proper Nail Placement:** Position spikes about 1/2" from the edge to prevent curling or lifting.
- **Trimming for a Perfect Fit:** Trim excess material around any structure with a sharp utility knife. Leave a small gap to accommodate natural movement and prevent overly tight cuts.
- **Cutting Around Objects:** When trimming around trees, fences, or other obstacles, use notches to allow the grass to lay naturally.

Completing Your Evergreen Artificial Grass Project

- 1. Avoid installing the grass during rain events or in areas where there is standing water.
- 2. Allow 24 hours for the seam glue to bond and cure before brooming or cleaning the grass.
- 3. Once cured, fluff the turf by using a power broom or rake to complete your installation.
